



ORWALL Park Rules

Basic park rules are posted at the North and South main entrances.

While common sense should prevail in all instances, the following are posted and must be followed by everyone.

- ORWALL facilities (fields, practice fields, batting cages) are for use by registered ORWALL players and teams ONLY.
- No player warm-ups in the common areas. Swinging bats and throwing baseballs must be done:
 - On the field of play
 - On the ORWALL practice field (large grass field with four backstops)
 - There is no live batting by players on the practice field unless wiffle balls are being used.
 - In a batting tunnel
 - Batting tunnel pitchers must use L-Screen
- No unauthorized vehicles inside the park.
- No skateboards, rip sticks, roller blades (this includes hover boards).
- No bicycles or scooters (this includes jet packs, ATVs, and pterodactyls) - Basically, anything outside of natural bi-pedal propagation is prohibited unless medically necessary.
- No children under 7 years old permitted in score boxes.
- No pets – this includes “emotional support” animals.
 - Bona fide service animals are permitted IAW Texas Human Resources Code
- No tobacco or alcohol.
 - This includes vaporizers (“vaping” is prohibited at the park)
- No abusive language.
- No firearms or fireworks.

Abiding by these rules makes the park enjoyable for everyone. Thank you for choosing ORWALL and playing it safe around the park!
